


Earn Mainpro+® Credits from Using Your HQCA *Primary Healthcare Panel Report*

Family physicians can use the HQCA's *Provincial Primary Healthcare Patient Panel* reports to enhance their knowledge and stimulate practice improvement. They can also earn both certified and non-certified Mainpro+ credits from using the report and attending webinars. Group Learning	Provincial Primary Healthcare Patient Panel Report Webinars		Claim time spent in HQCA webinars to learn more about one of the reports – 1 credit per hour. In the Mainpro+ system, select Group Learning → Non-certified → Other Activities.
Self-Learning	Provincial Primary Healthcare Patient Panel	Linking Learning to Practice Linking Learning to Administration – When reading the HQCA panel report raises a question about your practice that you then investigate further, or stimulates a change in practice or office processes, write that up as a Linking Learning to Practice or Administration exercise. 5 certified credits	Claim time spent reading HQCA reports – 1 credit per hour. In the Mainpro+ system, select Self-Learning → Non-certified → Other Activities.
