When reviewing your panel report raises a question about your practice that you then investigate further, or stimulates a change in practice or office processes, write that up as a Linking Learning to Assessment exercise or practice audit. 5 certified credits – Linking Learning to Assessment 6 certified credits – Practice Audit</p>	<p>Claim time spent reviewing your HQCA panel report – 1 credit per hour. <i>In the Mainpro+ system, select Assessment → Non-certified → Practice Audit.</i></p> <p>Claim time spent with your clinic team in planning and implementing improvements to your practice as a result of reviewing the panel report – 1 credit per hour. <i>In the Mainpro+ system, select Self-Learning → Non-certified → Other Activities.</i></p>
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
