


58% of eligible patients in Alberta complete recommended colorectal cancer screening. This is the lowest rate of all preventative

**KEYS TO SUCCESS** for PCNs and clinics, as heard from those exceeding the provincial average:

#### **CREATE:**



- Cultures supportive of quality improvement and a commitment to talk about it with your team
- Well-defined patient panels
- Opportunities to explain the Fecal Immunochemical Test (FIT) to demystify and simplify the process for patients

#### **MAXIMIZE:**

EMR capabilities to flag eligible patients



- Collaboration, team work, and the expertise of panel managers and improvement facilitators
- The use of **data**, and use it to create competition

# **KEYS TO SUCCESS** for physicians:



- MEASURE Know your data. Know your peer's data.
  - **ACT** Make a change, pick something to improve.
- COMPETE Challenge one another to make improvements.

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
