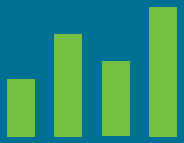
**It's easy to get started.** Simply click on COVID-19 Vaccinations from the home page of your report.

**Get focused.** View vaccination data by the priority groups or check out your full panel of patients. If you hover over the icons, you can easily see what age category is included in each phase.



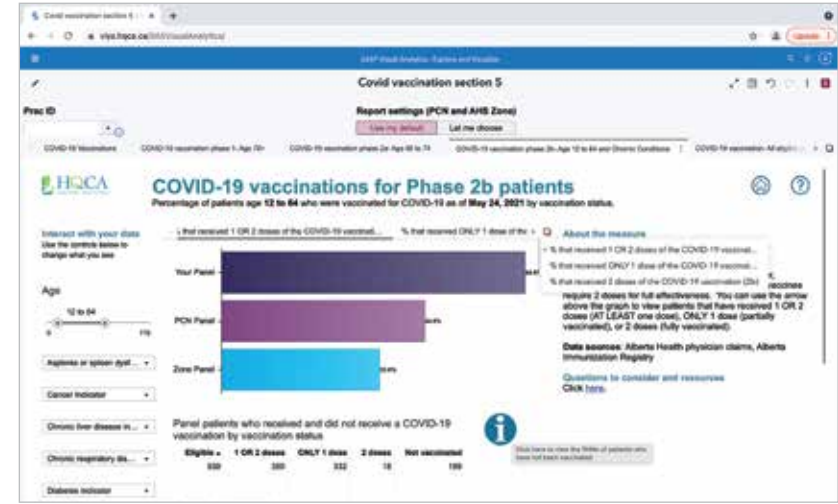
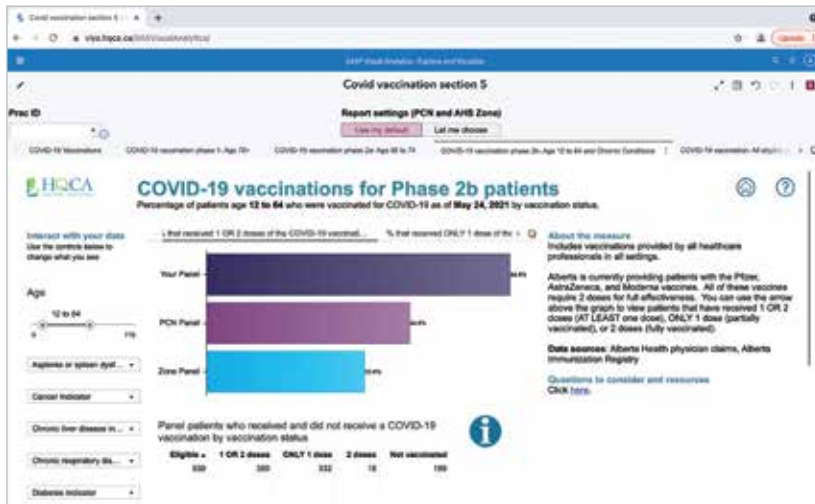


# A Guide to Check Your Patient Vaccination Data

DRIVE IMPROVEMENT. MANAGE YOUR PANEL. IMPROVE PATIENT CARE.

**4** Compare your panel's vaccination data with PCNs and Zones across the province.

**5** See who needs a COVID-19 vaccination. Click on **i** to view the personal health numbers (PHNs) of patients who have not been vaccinated.



**6** Export the PHNs so you can assess where patient follow-up is required.

**7** Check back on a recurring basis. The HQCA updates vaccination data every week.

**COVID-19: Questions to consider and resources**

**Consider**

- If vaccination rates are low
- If your vaccination rate is lower than expected or is not improving over time, consider using vaccination promotion strategies with your patients. It could also mean that your patients are receiving their vaccination from a program that is not captured in the data.
